- Update from meeting with Ben George John reported that whilst Ben was

 problematic in the next 8 months with so many schemes to implement. He is
 happy to take any modifications of the INM map to include new route proposals.
 He also said that he is awaiting Councillor input on the next steps for Walter Rd.
 He stated that he is happy for Nick to E-mail him re signage issues
- Discussion of future work It was felt that after the substantial sums of money that are to be spent in the next year on the Eastside, Wheelrights should for the next year concentrate on the North of Swansea bounded by Neath Rd. to the North and in the West by Walter Rd., Glanmor Rd. Cockett Rd. and Waunarllwyd Rd. to Gowerton. ACTION- Routes group to look at possible routes with 3 suggestions 1. from Penllerager to Gowerton/Gorseinon. 2. to consider a branch route from Llewitha Common to the surgery on Carmarthen Rd possibly by joining with Denver Rd. Kingsway, Queensway Cwmbach Rd. and Church gardens and then running parallel to Gors Ave. 3. to think about a route from Penllergaer woods to Penplas Rd and then across Mynydd Newydd fields to Penlan and then down across Manselton 'racecourse' to St john's Rd.
- Other routes in this area have already been identified i.e. Tirpenry Route under Clase Rd., an off road route from Cwm Arian alongside Clydach Rd. to Llanllienwern Rd., Cwmgelli route to the DVLA, Walter Rd and finally Townhill/Mayhill routes. These are the routes that the Campaign group will be concentrating on as all are reasonably easy to deliver. John reported on a proposed meeting with Townhill councillors and Gwalia Housing who have bought the old UWTSD site on Pantycelin Rd.
