Notes of meeting on 21st January 2014 in the Environment Centre, Swansea

1. Matters arising from 3 September 2013 meeting and not on agenda.

Links to Fabian Way campus.

DN summarised the situation: a link from Swansea using NCR 4 to the Swansea/NPT border and then going under Baldwin bridge should be constructed soon. RW noted that Network Rail are agreeable to the route being taken across the railway lines north of Fabian Way, failing this the existing route on the north footway will be upgraded.

A direct route through the docks was aspirational as was a route south of Fabian Way from the east. JC noted that the latter had been taken up with NPT's Geoff Marquis (who had accepted it as an aspirational route) about a year ago and felt that we should pursue this. It was agreed that we should seek another meeting with Geoff. **[Action JC, DN]**

2. Workshop on cycle routes

We divided into three groups as follows:

3. AOB

- (b) <u>WeCycle</u>. RW reported that WeCycle were moving from Swansea to Margam Park.
- (c) <u>Urban Cyclery</u>. NG reported that Urban Cyclery were moving to Kingsbridge.
- (d) <u>Dylan Thomas Centenary ride</u>. DN reported that this ride from Laugharne to Swansea would take place on 6 July. starting at 10.00am.
- (e) <u>Nigel Jenkins</u> is very ill so will not be available for the GCF Dylan Thomas Trail ride.
- (f) <u>NCR 43</u>. Completion of the diversion has been delayed by the wet weather. RW noted however that the shared use path alongside Beaufort Road is now complete.
- (g) <u>High Street Station</u>. RW reported that 40 more Sheffield stands were to be added on Platforms 1 and 4.
- (h) <u>Liberty Stadium</u>. PE reported that cycle stands were to be added here.
- (i) <u>Sail Bridge</u>. DN reported that the hoops on the Sail Bridge east barrier were to be removed. RW noted that work which was about to start on removing these had been stopped by the Welsh Government.
- (j) <u>Metro style maps</u>. RW explained that a website is planned together with a video to promote the routes portrayed.
